DISCUSSION/INFORMATIONAL ITEM:

a. Overview of Land Development Applications Submitted to the Town by Loudoun County

David Mekarski briefly reviewed the Boundary Line Adjustment phasing and the presentation given by Loudoun County in 2018 at a community meeting as well as the Rezoning and SUP Process document.

Council member Rayner talked about concerns from the Mayfair HOA to include traffic, lighting, parking and noise.

Members of Council expressed concerns with the short timeline associated with Planning Commission and Council public hearings and action.

Mark Hoffman gave the County's presentation (attached). The Planning Commission discussed

concerns for holding a public hearing in two weeks. The County will provide the documents as listed in the presentation to the Planning Commission and Town Council for review before setting a timeline. This allows time for evaluation of the projects and to determine a realistic timeline.

Dan Carvill, Apsley Terrace, came forward and talked about resident safety concerns due to traffic with Mayfair Crown Drive. Mayor Fraser requested this item be added to the next meeting and invite County representatives to discuss a plan. Mr. Mekarski stated public works staff would look at sidewalks, crosswalks and other street related items.
